After the Rally, the students had enacted the role play on tuberculosis incidence, risk factors, signs and symptoms, mode of transmission & diagnostic procedures such as chest X-Ray, Sputum examination, mantoux test, CBNAT (Cartridge Based Nucleic Acid Amplification Test) current treatment regimen (DOTS therapy), protein rich diet and preventive measures to be followed to avoid the transmission of Tuberculosis from one to another.
