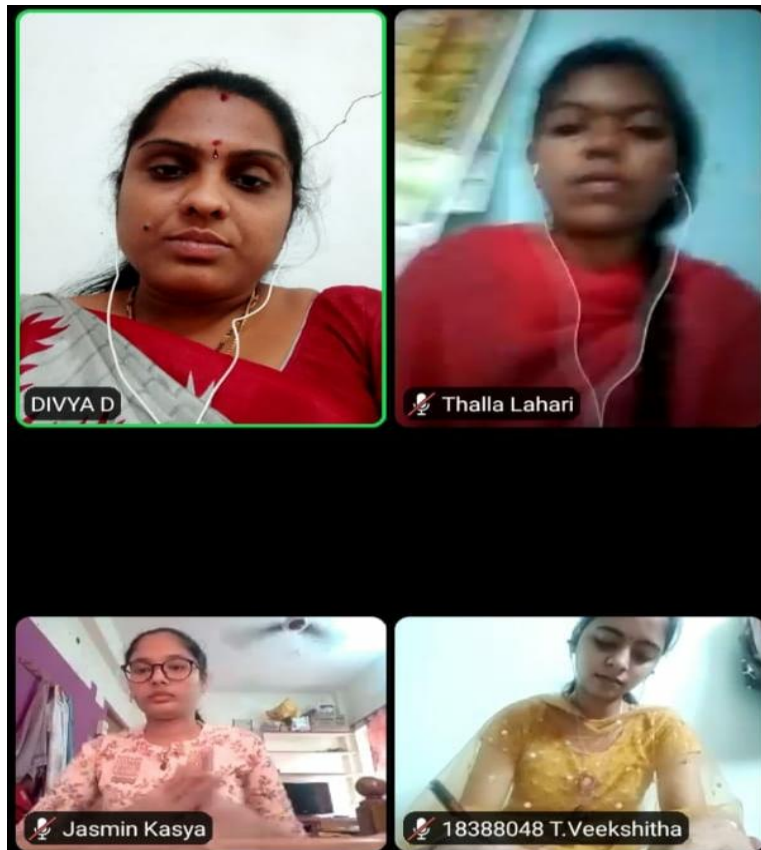

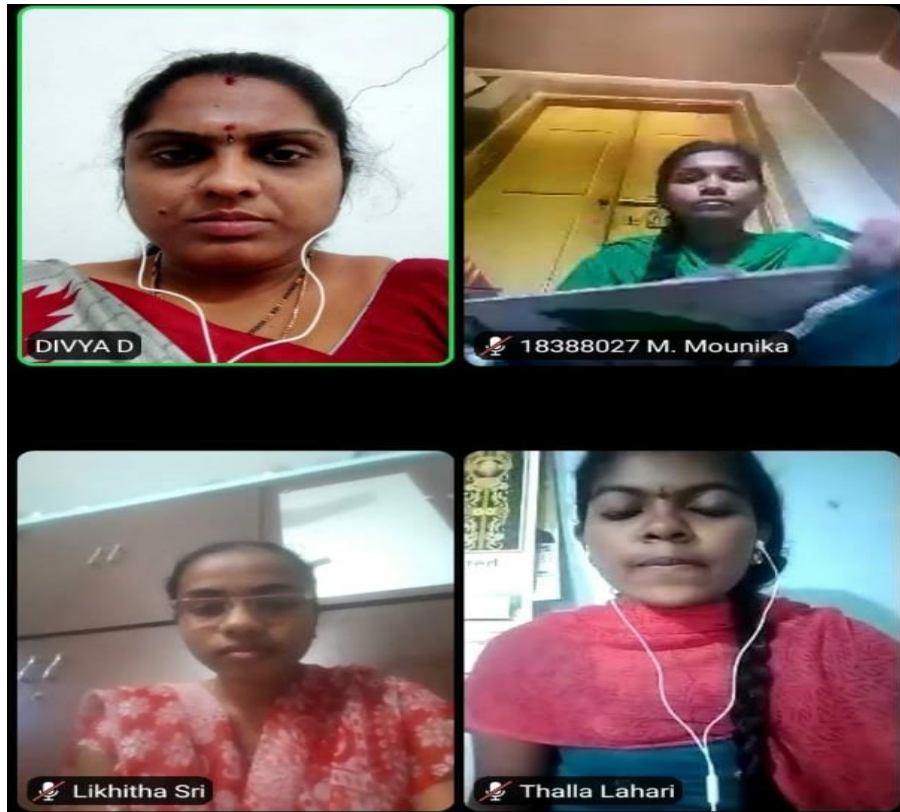
**NATIONAL GIRL CHILD DAY-2022**

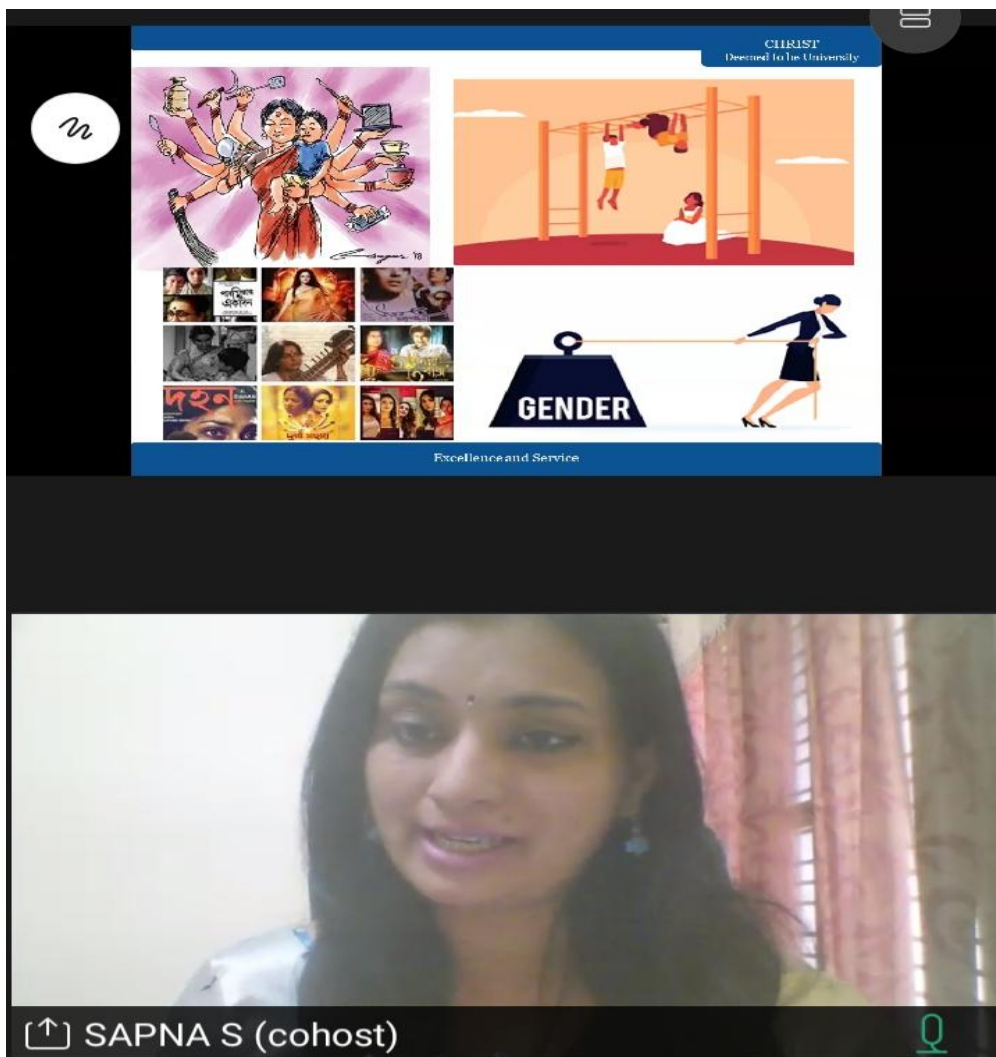
**STUDENTS TAKE PART IN ESSAY WRITING COMPETITIONS VIRTUALLY**



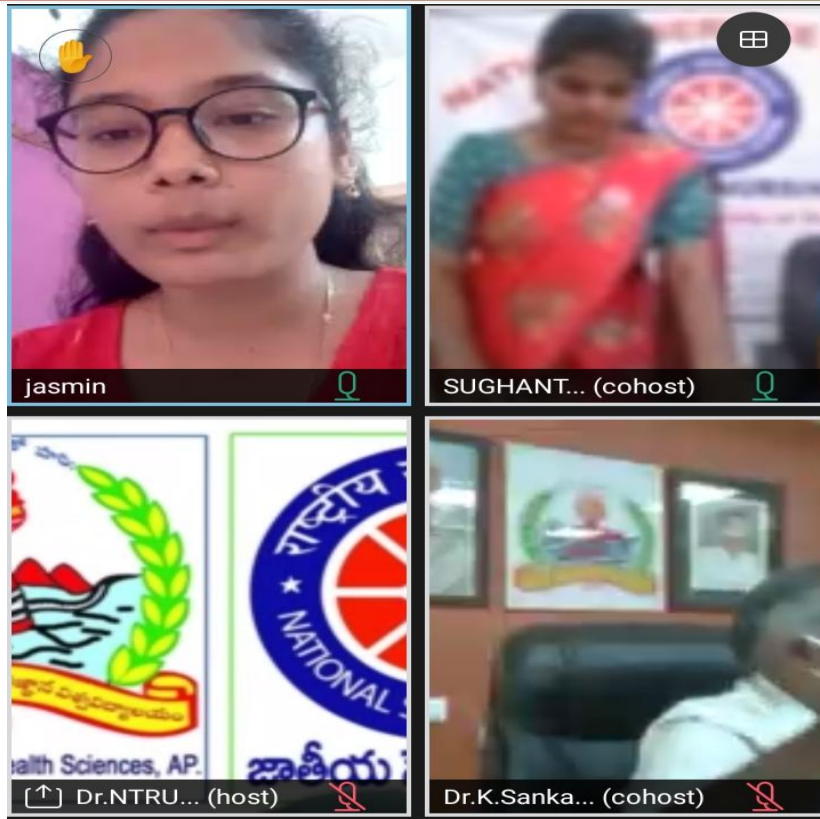
