We collaborated with several hospitals and trusts for conducting blood donation camp such as **Govt. Maternity hospital, SVRRGGH, SVIMS, SVS Charitable trust, and NTR Memorial trust**. On the day of blood donation, Screening tests are taken to identify the eligible donor for blood donation.
