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CNE REPORT ON "E-LEARNING APPROACHES IN NURSING EDUCATION"

Continuing Nursing Education Program has organized on 27th January, 2025 with the theme "E-learning Approaches in Nursing Education" at Sree Vidyanikethan college of Nursing, Tirupati by Dr. Roja Chokkara, Associate professor and Dr. M.S.Shareef, Professor under the leadership of Dr. Prathima P, Principal Sree Vidyanikethan College of Nursing. The aim of the CNE programme was to enhance the E-learning skills to the Nursing students.

Finally, discussed with benefits and challenges of E-learning. The session was ended with summarization of the topic and group discussion.

The students were very actively participated throughout the session. The CNE program came to an end with the post-test.


