The Mass drug administration and Awareness Programme on "National Deworming Day" was conducted on 17th February 2026 with the theme of "Worm-Free Kids, Brighter Futures" at Schools located in Bakara peta and Kandulavari palli, Rangam Pet village, Tirupati by Seventh semester and Fourth year B.Sc Nursing students. The programme was organized by Dr. Roja Chokkara, Associate Professor, under the leadership of Dr.P. Lavnya, Principal, SVCN. The aim of the programme was to enhance the overall health, nutritional status, and quality of life of children aged 1-19 years by reducing the prevalence of soil-transmitted helminthic infections through mass drug administration and health education.

A total of eight schools such as ZPHS school, MPP School, Kandhulavari primary school, Vinayaka Vidhya Mission school from Kandhulavari Palle and Sai Ram public school, Geethanjali Public school, MPP school, ZPHS school from Bhakra pet were participated in this programme.

The programme commenced with awareness sessions focusing on proper hand washing techniques, the importance of deworming tablets, and preventive measures such as nail hygiene, consumption of safe drinking water, proper washing and cleaning of vegetables and fruits, maintenance of hand hygiene, avoidance of open defecation and avoid barefoot.

A total of 48 IV Year and 42 VII Semester B.Sc. Nursing students actively participated in the programme. In addition, five ASHA workers, two ANMs, and school teachers were involved in the successful implementation of the programme.


