- Guide participants in preparing an effective professional resume and portfolio for national and international career opportunities.

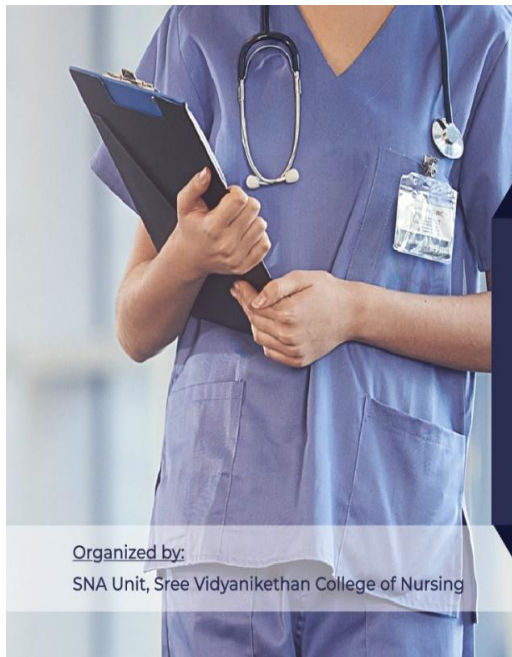



With 14 years of experience at Apollo Hospitals and academia, plus an MBA in Hospital Administration, Mrs. Padmakumari gave a step-by-step guide to building a professional nursing portfolio. She covered academic transcripts, clinical logbooks, certificates, research projects, APNMC registration, INC norms, and digital e-portfolios. Her session bridged the gap between student life and professional readiness.
